#### Additional Major Requirements:

The following courses need to be completed to take upper division courses in specific majors:

- FIN 295 for all Finance courses
- MGT 295 for all Management courses
- MKT 295 for all Marketing courses
- MIS 201 for all Management Information Systems courses
- STAT 201 must be taken no later than the first semester of being an upper division student for the following majors: Accounting, Finance, and Marketing

#### To Remain in the School of Business:

- Students accepted into upper division status are **required to maintain a minimum 2.50 cumulative and major GPA**. These minimums are required in order to graduate from the School of Business.
- Students whose GPA drops below a 2.50 will be subject to removal from the School of Business.
