



## Graduate Planned Program of Study

The graduate planned program of study (GPPS) lists the courses and other requirements that must be completed prior to program completion or graduation. The GPPS is not official until your academic advisor signs and approve it and it is processed by the Registrar's office; it must be submitted before the completion of 15 course credits. (An earlier submission is recommended.) The official copy is retained in the student's university academic record. If changes are made to the GPPS and approved by the advisor, a course substitution form or a revised GPPS may be submitted. The graduate planned program of study does not constitute a contract, either expressed or implied. Additional requirements may be imposed for certification or licensure if such requirements are imposed by outside certification or licensure agencies. The GPPS may be subject to revision to reflect such additional requirements.
