

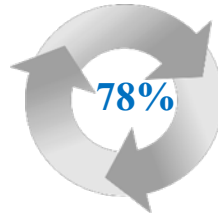

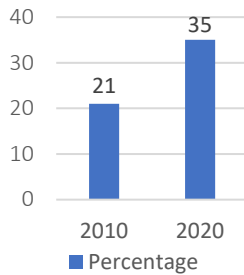

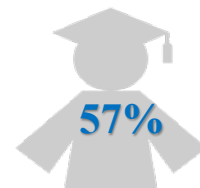

## Official Graduation Rate

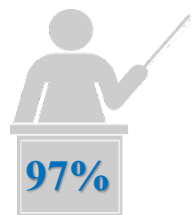
