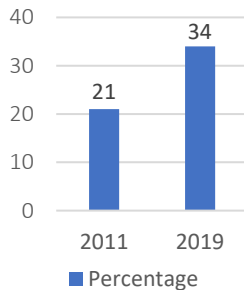

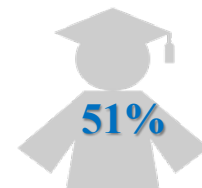

## Official Graduation Rate

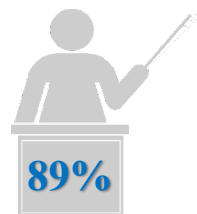
