

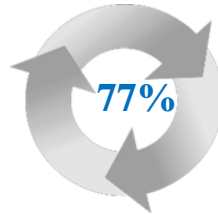

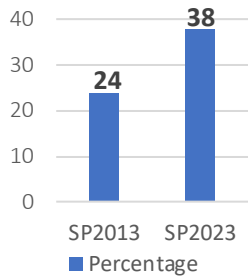


Official Retention Rate

Number of Students by Race/Ethnicity

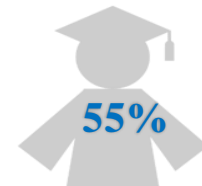

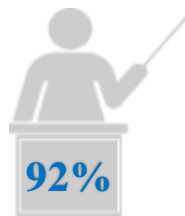
